
Circleworks

Circleworks is used to segment blocks and circles when you need to space designs accurately. Circleworks is also use to segments circles when designing circular quilts.


!Circleworks is available in 3 sizes




The 12" and 24" Circleworks use a single pin and pin lock

The 36" Circleworks uses a single pin and pin lock and a location disk.


Remember when drawing use the finest pen or pencil. I use a .5 mechanical pencil or a .5 Frixion pen. You need to use a fine pen to avoid inaccuracy.




Circleworks for segmenting
Begin with a square or a circle
Locate the centre, the easiest way to locate the centre
is to draw a crosshair - marking from corner to corner.




Now from underneath place the locating pin at the centre, and place the pin lock over the pin to secure. Place Circleworks over the pin. Your are now ready to play.



First mark the circles.
Place your pen in the circle hole and rotate circleworks





Mark as many circles as you wish to work with.




Now, mark in the segments the quarters first. shown in Red.

Mark the first line and then roate the template for the number of segments you want and mark the next line.






Mark all the circles and rotations you want.




With the circles and rotations mark you can now have by sewing or drawing in the lines to complete the pattern.

Once you have draw all the circles and segments you can now have fun designing your pattern.



When using with your longarm quilting machine use Circles on Quilts to sew the circles and Circleworks to mark any circles not to be guilted.



Circles on Quilts

With Circles on Quilts you can sew concentric circles from 1" to 12" and for the first time at 1/8th increments.

You can use Circles on Quilts to sew Baptist Fans as never before.

With our simple single pin rotation for your template. the Circles on Quilts range is super easy to position on your quilt.



The Spinning Waves will cover up to a 12" block

The Wreaths and other Circles sew to 11.5" to fit a 12" block, 7.5" to fit an 8" block, 5.5" to fit a 6" block.
