

ZipR[®] Trim

Flower Project



- Trace the template onto a sheet of heavy duty cardboard or plastic.
- Cut a length of ZipR[®] trim 1 ½ yards long. Apply seam sealant to the raw edges.
- Have your sewing machine set up for a button stitch as wide as your machine will make.
- Begin by making a loop over one of the points. Secure with a pin.
- Loop over all the points (the shape of the star will automatically cover each point) until you have covered all the points twice and three of the points a third time.
- Carefully remove the loops from the template. Slide a backing piece approximately 2" square behind all the loops.
- Carefully stitch all the layers together with the button stitch.
- Hand sew a pin back to the backing trim.
- You may wish to place some glue between the backing and the flower for extra stability.
- Add a crystal button in the center to finish this flower



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
