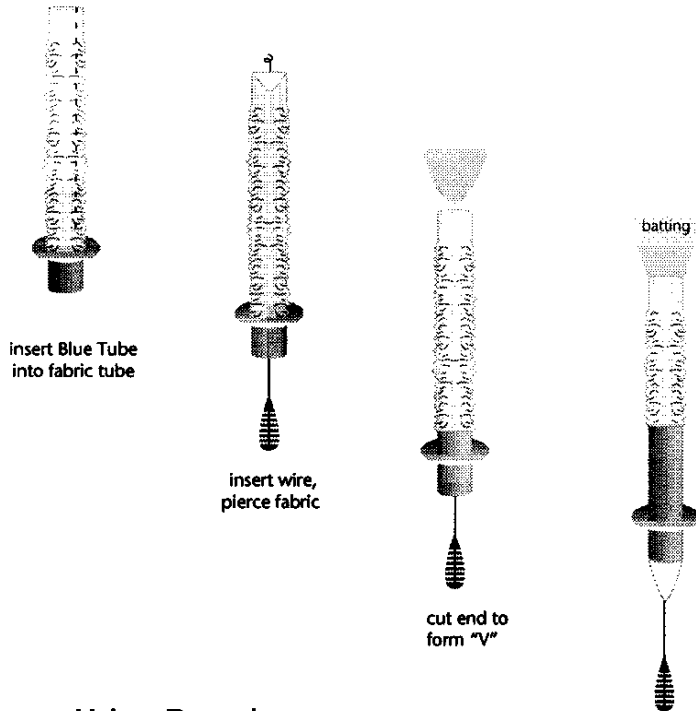


The Blue Tube Instructions

Blue Tube Turning

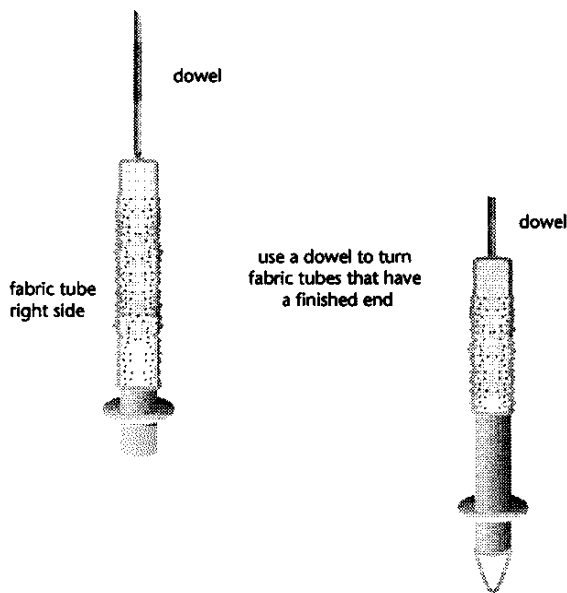


3 new diameters: 1", 1¼", and 1½" by 18" long for turning longer, wider or bulkier fabric tubes.

The Blue Tube can be used for turning by using the new longer and strong wire or your own wooden dowel. Turn fabric tube with wire or push a finished end of fabric tube through the cylinder with a wooden dowel.

Magically fill a fabric tube while you turn. So easy and so fast! Place wrong side out fabric tube on the Blue Tube. Make sure to cover the end of blue tube with very end of fabric tube. Insert wire into end of fabric. Pull wire handle so the fabric pulls into blue tube about one inch. Now just touch the end of the fabric tube to the V cut end of a piece of batting. It magically draws in the batting at the same time as it turns the fabric tube.. Perfect for decorator soft stuffed cords, wreaths, garlands and baskets.

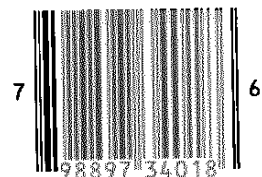
Using Dowel

Also, Decorating With Fabric Tubes (FP-200) uses fabric tubes for easy open lattice curtains, tablecloths and place mats. Beautiful Pretzel Twist curtain tie backs and larger batting filled piping for bedspreads and valances are simple fill techniques using FASTURN and Blue Tubes. The Blue Tube is also excellent for making 2" or 2½" Flat Belts.
