

# Inn-Spire™ by Innovative Craft Products



**Inn-Spire™** is a revolutionary, stiff, mouldable, non-woven stabilizer to cover in your own fabric to create bowls, boxes, totes, containers, vases and so much more. I hope Inn-Spire™ inspires creativity in you.

To make a similar flower as shown above, we have made the following something you may make without any pattern, simply draw a flower shape like you did in kindergarten when you learnt to draw.

## **Requirements:**

Fabric, Double-Sided Fusible Web such as Vliesofix, Misty-Fuse, Steam-A-Seam, Heat 'n Bond Lite, Appli-Kay Wonder or Trans-Web. <http://www.punchwithjudy.com.au/shop/fusibles-for-applique/>  
Paper or Template Plastic, Iron, Pencil, Scissors.



**Instructions:**

1. Make a simple flower template in 3 sizes eg. 5cm, 9cm & 13cm diameter
2. Apply fusible web to the wrong side of the fabric
3. Fuse fabric to both sides of a suitable size piece of Inn-Spire using fusible web instructions
4. Trace template onto one side
5. Cut out the design



6. Heat flower shape with an iron then place over a bowl
7. Whilst still warm, shape to suit, hold till cool
8. When cool, remove the shape from the bowl

9. Re-heat just the tips of the petals and shape as desired



10. Or, you may heat and shape by hand without using a bowl

11. Make Leaf shapes as per above

12. Shape leaves by pinching and bending



13. Layer 3 different sizes and either sew through the middle or glue together just in the centres
